All About an Opening of Private Jaw Surgery Clinic

There was a time when the two-jaw surgery was very popular. At that time, not only did many dental school students apply for OMS training courses to learn and study the two-jaw surgery but OMS surgeons with OMS training were offered attractive job opportunities from private jaw surgery clinics.

The fad, however, didn't last forever and the popularity of OMS seems to be on the wane. The calm following the disturbance seems to be relatively more shabby, so now the popularity of oral maxillofacial surgery seems to be more waned.

In this situation, private OMS clinics are usually cited as a culprit for the decline of OMS because OMS clinics do not prosper in the market, which leads dental schools students away from OMS training.

As for me, since I completed my OMS training 7 years ago, I have worked as an OMS faculty in a few private jaw surgery clinics. This year, I have finally started an OMS jaw surgery clinic.

Based on my experience over 7 years, I would like to give you some tips on starting a private jaw surgery clinic. Besides, interviews with other OMS surgeons, who are directors of private OMS clinics, will be included.

I will review the current market status of private jaw surgery clinics, the fierce competition with plastic surgery clinics, requirements to start a jaw surgery clinic, and finally various survival tips as a private OMS clinic.

I hope this lecture can make junior OMS surgeons proud of our department and provide them with a practical help for their future career.
